

## 4.1 Remote Users: Laptop & Docking Station



### **Getting Started**

Within our Region, most Laptops are setup with a Docking Station & second monitor. There are a variety of models currently being used, but the basic features will remain the same for all & will look similar to the picture below.





#### **Opening & Closing the Laptop:**

1. Open the laptop by sliding the Lock Button to the right & pull lid up



- 2. Press the 'On' button (see illustrations on previous page)
- 3. Log on to your laptop (see User Guide 'Logging On, Logging Off, Locking & Unlocking Your Computer')
- 4. To close, simply shut down & push the screen down onto the keyboard. Press firmly until you hear a click

#### Placing the Laptop on a Docking Station

1. A Docking Station is a simply way of connection your Laptop to power, the network & external monitor & will look similar to the one below:



2. To place you Laptop on the Docking Station, find the small line on the top of the Laptop & line it up with the small line on the Docking Station



3. Place the Laptop on top of the small mounting at the front of the Docking Station & press down firmly until it clicks into place



4. To remove the Laptop from the Docking Station, press the release button on the top right of the Docking Station
