7. Tap 'Email' & type in your email address using the pop-up keyboard



8. Tap 'Username' & type the username you use to log into your workplace computer each day (e.g. *tony.anderson* or *tanderson*)

9. Tap 'Password' & type your password. To change from low-case

to upper case, press the arrow in bottom left corner of popup keyboard & select the first letter for your password then type the rest of your password. Switch to number keyboard as instructed above

- 11. Tap 'Server' & type the server address for your workplace as listed below
