

Creating a Zoom account

Zoom is the video conferencing solution used by Aboriginal Medical Services within the IT@RAMS consortium. This document will show you how to create an account and associate it with the IT@RAMS Zoom business group. Being a part of the business group will allow you access to the contact directory for the sites and also individuals.

Creating a Zoom account for video conferencing is very easy and only requires an email address that you can access.

Follow the below steps to create your account.

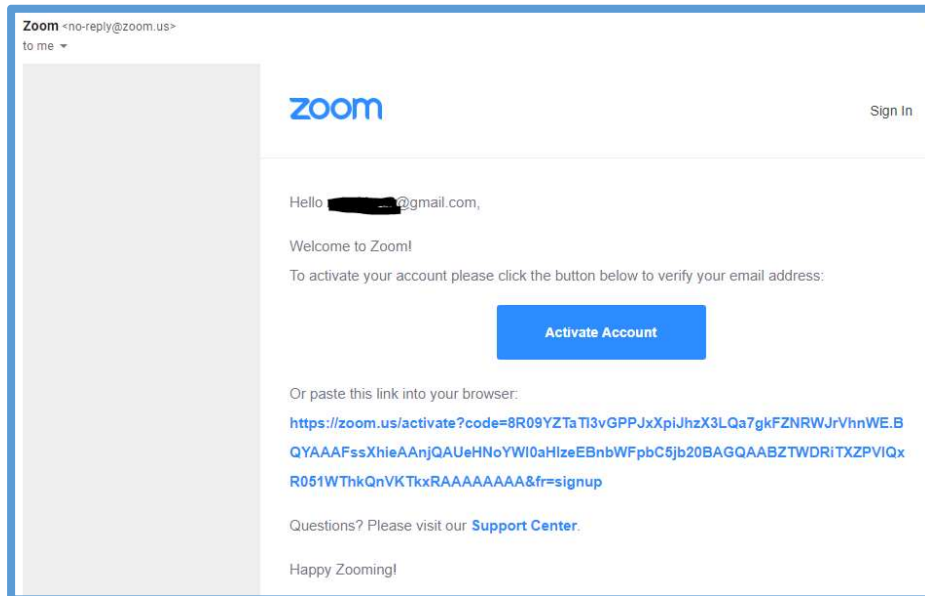

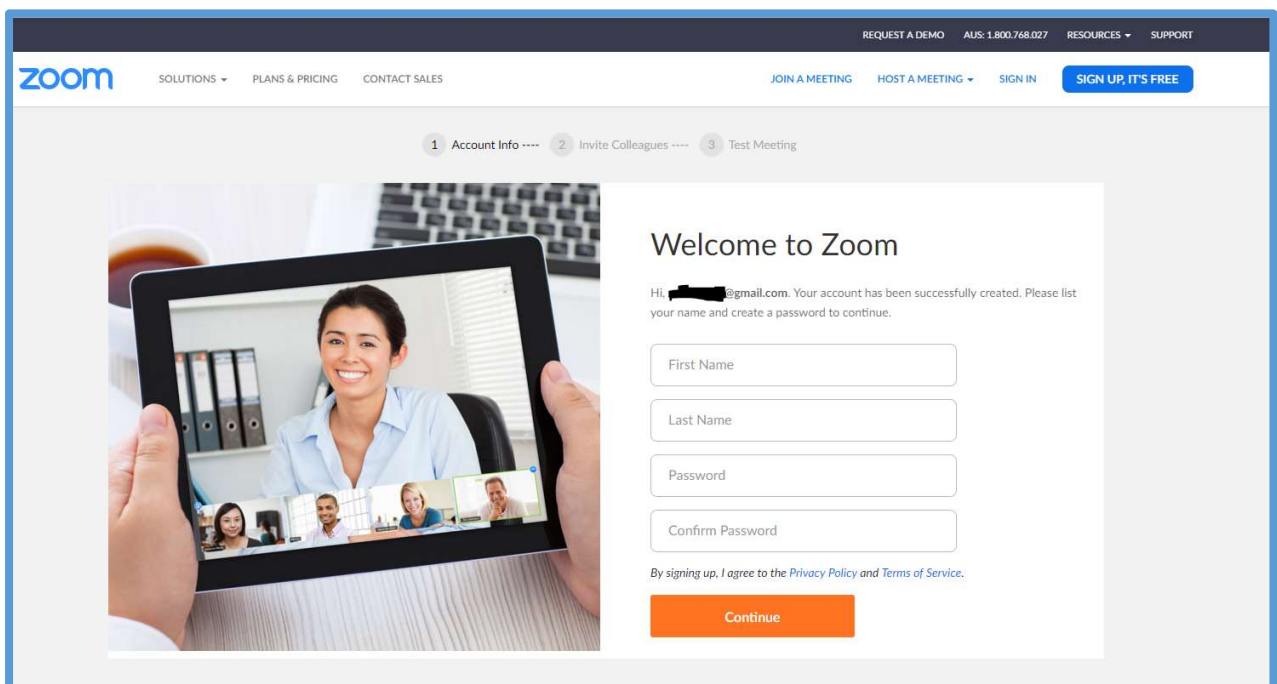
3. Check Your Email

Check your email for the link to activate your account, clicking the Activate Account link will take you to the Zoom activation page.



4. Activate Your Account

On the activation page, you will just need to enter your first and last name plus create and confirm your Zoom password.



Once this is done and you have successfully activated your Zoom account.

Installing Zoom

Once your account is activated, you can sign in to Zoom from the [sign in option](https://zoom.us/signin) (<https://zoom.us/signin>) on the home page.

The Zoom client will download automatically when you start or join your first Zoom meeting and is also available for download [here](https://zoom.us/download#client_4meeting) (https://zoom.us/download#client_4meeting)

The Zoom app is also available in the App Store for Apple devices and the Play Store for Android devices.

NOTE: Users are required to provide their own video conferencing kit (video camera, microphone and speakers) for any tele-health consultations or any other video conference meetings arranged with any organisation within IT@RAMS.
